

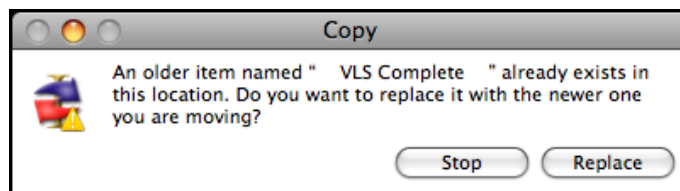

## INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS (COMPLETE):

- 1.) Download the Patch for the Complete CD-ROM from the following website to your desktop:  
[http://visuallinklanguages.com/downloads/mac/patches/beta\\_projectors.zip](http://visuallinklanguages.com/downloads/mac/patches/beta_projectors.zip)
- 2.) Decompress the Zip Archive:
  - a. Note: Please use the default system archive manager (BOMArchiveHelper), using a different Archive Manager (e.g. Stuffit) may result in your program behaving erratically. (See illustration below in step 2c for an example)
  - b. Right Click on the zip file, choose 'Open with' and select 'Archive Utility'.
  - c.

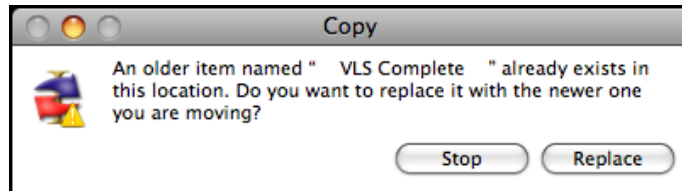


- 3.) This will create a folder for you named "Archive." This folder will contain two sub folders, one called "Complete CD", and the other called "Pronunciation CD". Each of these folders contain two files, each of which you will need to move into the appropriate installation directory.
- 4.) For the Complete CD-ROM, you will need to open the folder "Complete CD", and move the TWO files located within this folder to your installation directory. Instructions on how to do this are below:
  - a. Open "Applications"
  - b. Open the folder "Visual Link Spanish" inside of "Applications"
  - c. Open the folder "Level I Complete CD" inside of "Visual Link Spanish"
  - d. Move the files "VLS Complete", and "mindex.swf" that are in the "Complete CD" folder, that you unzipped previously, to the "Level I Complete CD" folder
  - e. When told that the files already exist in this directory with the same name, select "Replace".
  - f.



- 5.) For the Pronunciation CD-ROM, you will need to open the folder "Pronunciation CD" that was extracted from the file you downloaded. Within this folder, there are two files that will need to be moved to the installation directory. Instructions are below:
  - a. Open "Applications"

- b. Open the folder "Visual Link Spanish" inside of "Applications"
- c. Open the folder "Level I Pronunciation CD" inside of "Visual Link Spanish"
- d. Move the files "Pronunciation" and "index.swf" that are in the "Pronunciation CD" folder, that you unzipped previously, to the "Level I Pronunciation CD" folder
- e. When told that the files already exist in this directory with the same name, select "Replace".
- f.



Once these steps have been completed, launch the programs to verify the installation by clicking the icons in your dock, or using the shortcuts that are on the desktop. If you are presented with a screen saying that the program was downloaded from the internet, select "Allow". You should not be presented with this dialog again after pressing "Allow".
